The test was written by a coalition of citizens from across the United States and reflects the PCEG's concerns with Congressional partisan divide, corporate manipulation, and political decision-making processes often infiltrated by unscientific and factually incorrect information.

Following the lead of those in our government that have embraced the standardized test as the measure of progress and potential in others, our Standardized Test for Congress does the same for our elected officials.
